Refer to the Supplemental Declarations if information is not shown on this form. This endorsement is subject to the *terms* contained in *your* policy.

ADDED PROPERTY EXCLUSION

The following Exclusion is added to the EXCLUSIONS THAT APPLY TO PROPERTY COVERAGES contained in *your* policy.

WHAT WE DO NOT PAY FOR

The property coverages contained in *your* policy do not apply to *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. *We* do not pay for loss or damage caused directly or indirectly by *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. *We* do not pay for clean-up costs or remediation caused by *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. However, this exclusion does not apply to *drilling* operations solely for a residential water supply or residential water well.

ADDED LIABILITY EXCLUSION

The following exclusion is added to the EXCLUSIONS contained the Liability Coverage Section of *your* policy. This additional exclusion applies to both Coverage L and Coverage M of *your* policy.

WHAT WE DO NOT PAY FOR

Coverage L and Coverage M of *your* policy do not apply to *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. *We* do not pay for *bodily injury*, *property damage* or *personal injury* caused by *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. *We* do not pay for clean-up costs or remediation caused by *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. *We* will have no duty to defend claims or suits, or pay expenses, arising out of *bodily injury*, *property damage* or *personal injury* caused by *hydrofracking* or *drilling* operations. However, this exclusion does not apply to *drilling* operations solely for a residential water supply or residential water well.

ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS

The following additional definitions apply to this endorsement:

- 1. *Hydrofracking* means any technique in which a mixture of water, sand, gas or chemicals is forced, injected or put down a well or into the ground, in order to create fractures in the rock intended to release natural resources.
- 2. **Drilling** means any process of exploration or extraction for natural resources that involves a technique in which an instrument with an edged or pointed end for making holes in hard substances by a revolving succession of turns or blows is used.

All other *terms* and conditions remain unchanged.
